Introduction (Part 1)

- October – November 2016
- Friend suggested I gather Scriptures surrounding the Presidential Election
- Discussed with Lance Wallnau about continuing in December
- He said: 'I'd like to see scriptural declarations!'
- I knew the Lord was directing me.

Introduction (Part 2)

- December 2016 – March 2017
- Directed by the Lord to write daily
- Posted on multiple Facebook groups
- March vision: Aaron and Hur supporting Moses' arms – Exodus 17:11–12

Step 1: Position Yourself to be Used of God

- Hunger for His Presence – Matthew 5:6
- Spend time talking/listening – James 1:4-5
- Study and read His Word – 2 Timothy 2:15

Step 2: Follow the Nuggets Placed Before You

- Pray for sensitivity to hear Him
- Keep a notebook handy
- Use Bible Gateway, Naves, Strong's
- You are unique – follow God's way for you

Step 3: What Focus has God Placed on Your Heart?

- Initial focus: word, picture, assignment
- Growth: scope may expand
- Compassion will grow as you speak His Word

Step 4: Begin to Write

- Writing takes time – begin with words or phrases
- The Lord will help you find rhythm
- Best to write, wait, reread
- Peace confirms it is done

Step 5: Remain Teachable

- Continue learning from Holy Spirit and leaders
- Ask trusted leaders for feedback
- Format/process may shift – trust the Lord's flow

Step 6: Seek to Increase in Discernment

- Luke 11:13 – Holy Spirit given to those who ask
- Philippians 1:9 – Overflow in knowledge and discernment
- 1 John 5:20 – Discernment to know who is genuine
